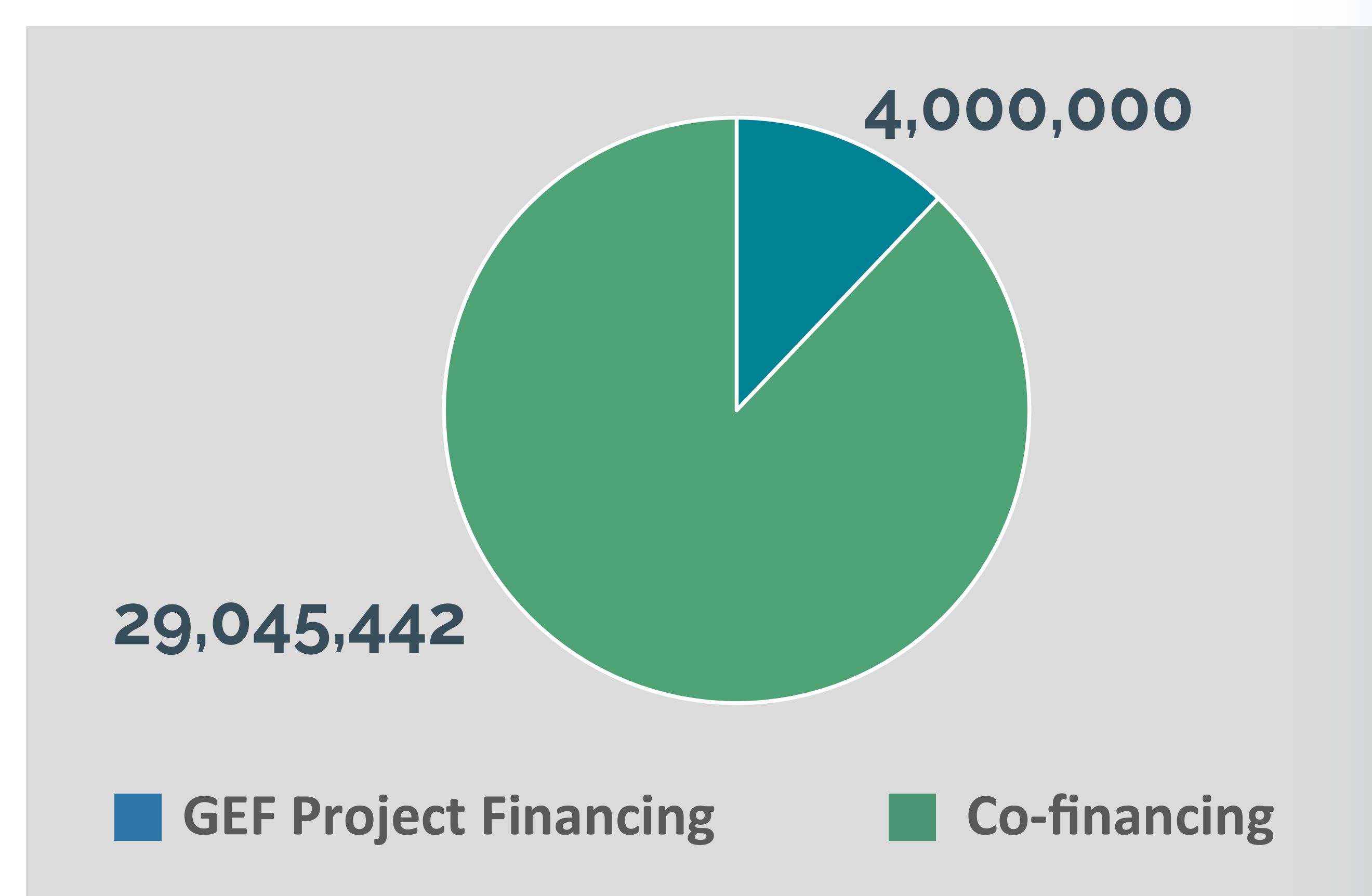

PROJECT TARGETS

- **15,000 ha under SLM** that
meet LDN criteria (of which
10,000 ha are croplands and
**5,000 ha are under mixed
land** cover types).
- Directly benefit a total of
10,000 people.
